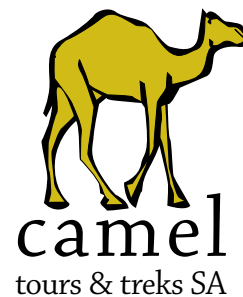

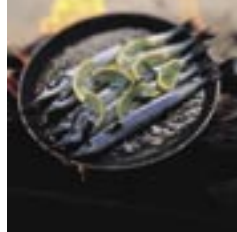

Fleurieu Bush Tracks... 2 hour camel riding tour

Enjoy riding through tall pine forest, native scrub, expansive views & spotting for flora & fauna on the Fleurieu Bush tracks tour. Lots of creature's call bush tracks home, what you spot depends on what time of year you ride. Maybe it'll be grey kangaroos, endangered black cockatoo's or wedge tailed eagles, wrens & robins, perhaps an echidna, shingle-back or blue tongue lizard? Whatever it might be, the view is always great riding atop a camel.

Bush tracks is available all year round, it's sheltered in the winter and shaded in the summer, suitable for all ages, enjoyed by couples, families and groups.

Bush tracks is located 1 hour south of Adelaide, surrounded by small cottage industry craft shops, nurseries, cellar doors, fruiterers and more in an unspoilt area of countryside.

Sir Richard Peninsula... 2 hour camel riding tour

Riding high seated in a comfortable saddle, you'll see the beach and dunes from an elevated perspective on one of our trusty camels. Feel the air saturate your lungs and absorb the pulse of the ocean at a relaxed pace.

This stretch of quiet coastline is of particular significance to our friends the Ramindjeri / Ngarrindgeri indigenous people, whose evidence of past history, can still be found today, tour guides will point out areas of interest.

One humped dromedary camels are powerful and robust animals that provide a relaxing rhythm, you may have heard the saying "ships of the desert". Couple this with the sound of the ocean and you're in for a summer chill-out & relax experience.

Come camel riding and enjoy the summer view, look as far as the eye can see, nothing but beach waits as we head in the direction of the Murray River mouth.

Sir Richard Peninsula tour is located 1.5 hours south of Adelaide at the historic township of Goolwa, which offers a village shopping experience, art & craft shops, cafes & restaurants and much more.
